**New Fire Department Construction**

Robert Summerfeldt presented the Council with an issue on the construction. Recent concrete PSI testing in the apparatus room failed with a test score of less than 50%. Mr. Summerfeldt confirmed the foundation was not an issue. He recommended having each section tested, which would consist of a cylinder shaped sample would be removed.

Mr. Summerfeldt answered the questions of the Council. He stated the contractor of the project has a copy of documentation that was provided to council. The additional testing cost would be at the contractor's expense. Mr. Summerfeldt confirmed a correct formula for the concrete was given to the concrete company and if mixed correctly, the samples would meet the PSI requirements.
